

Our Timeline



- 1947** - Organizes as the Caller-Times FCU; replaces a small savings club and loan service provided by Mr. Gilbert Veters, Managing Editor. 83 members with total assets of \$3,956.
- 1952** - First part-time paid employee. Prior to this, Mr. James Wesson was The volunteer manager.
- 1954** - First office opens on third floor of Caller-Times; 244 members and Assets of \$134,274.
- 1969** - Moves to rented space in store-front of building across the street from the Caller-Times.
- 1975** - Name changes to Harte-Hanks Federal Credit Union in November.
- 1987** - Starts Select Employee Group; 3,379 members.
- 1988** - Name changes to Homeport Federal Credit Union.
- 1991** - Southside office opens upstairs at 700 Everhart. Downtown location becomes branch office.
- 1993** - Moves downstairs at Everhart location, opens drive-thru service.
- 1995** - Appoints Martha Rodriguez as President.
- 1998** - 50th Anniversary. Passage of H.R. 1151 allowing credit unions to take new members.
- 2000** - Celebrates 53rd year in new century.
- 2002** - Introduces convenience of its own debit card.
- 2003** - Offers Home Equity Loans.
- 2004** - Offers Home Mortgage Loans.
- 2005** - Offers Overdraft Courtesy Pay.
- 2006** - Moves from Everhart to 5959 S. Staples. Installs ATM at downtown branch. Awarded highest rating (5-Stars) for strength and stability from the nation's leading Independent credit union rating and research firm, Bauer Financial, Inc.
- 2007** - Installs night depository at downtown branch. On May 24, receives Community Charter to service all residents and families that live, worship, attend school or do business in Nueces County.
- 2008** - Recognized as one of the best credit unions in Corpus Christi by Caller-Times readers.
